<u>Interview</u>

- ◆Interviews are arranged for ALL applicants. Details will be given in late February or early March.
- ◆Interviews are held in March 2026
- ◆Interviews are conducted in English and Cantonese. The whole process takes about 15 minutes.
- ◆The interviews are held individually. Students are required to read aloud an article in English and then answer some questions in both languages.
- Priority will be given to applicants with balanced and outstanding development in different aspects.
